




WRM guests and hungry people from the community are welcome in our dining room, where we serve more than 125 nutritious meals every day!

Nourishing people – physically, emotionally and spiritually – is one of the most important ministries at our new Park Street Center. Among the first guests in the facility, William came to us hungry – for food... and for hope.

With our guidance, he had overcome addiction earlier in life. But nine years later he struck up the battle again. "I got complacent and slid back into my old habits," he says. This time it cost him his livelihood, his home and nearly his family. "I was living in my truck and selling anything that had any value to get more drugs," he recalls. If he didn't change his ways, he believed his loved ones would be visiting him in jail, or even burying him.

So he turned to us again for meals... and the daily bread that would save his life.

In our Discipleship Recovery Program, he is studying the Bible and learning to embrace God's Word as the foundation for a meaningful, Christ-centered life. Classes in the education center offer practical skills and training for sober and independent living.

#### "You can't starve in this town with the Mission here. They really do care and have a genuine love for all people."

Today, as he prepares to return to his home and family, he says, "I'm more in tune with the Lord now and seeking Him in all that I do. The only thing that helped me turn my life around was putting Jesus at the helm of my ship, and that's what brought me back to the Mission."

This Easter, William will celebrate a beautiful new beginning – made possible by your generous support. "I feel a calling to help people who have been in my situation and to show them even if they fall like I did, the Lord is there with His arms wide open!"
